PACKING LIST

Clothing for 7 days:

- Underwear & socks
- Shirts
- Shorts and pants
- Sweatshirts and/or Warm jacket
- PJ's
- Swimming suit & extra towel
- Comfortable walking shoes (such as sneakers)
- Pool sandals
- Clothes for Messy Competitions (something that is ok to get dirty in...possibly very old clothes to dispose of afterwards?)



Personal Items:

- Toothbrush & paste
- Soap, shampoo, razor (if needed)
- Chapstick, lotion
- Hairbrush, comb, etc.
- Deodorant
- Feminine supplies (if needed)
- Sunscreen / after sun lotion



Other Items:

- Sleeping bag or bedding (twin size)
- Pillow
- Medications (if needed). *All meds must be listed on camper med form. Let us know if your child needs reminders to take meds or if you want staff to store/distribute.*
- Dirty laundry bag
- Flashlight
- Bath towels & Wash cloth
- REUSABLE Water Bottle w/name
- Medical Forms

Lost & Found: Please LABEL EVERYTHING! All personal clothing and/or equipment you bring to camp is your responsibility. If we find anything left behind, we will hold all items through September, at which time they will be donated to a charitable organization.

- Cash for Climbing Tower, Frozen Treats, Cold Drinks** Ice cream novelties, fruit juice bars and chilled drinks will be available for purchase during free time. Cash only please. \$2-5 per treat. Climbing Tower: \$15 (register on Sun)
- Fan** If you happen to have a fan—you may want to bring one to help cool your cabin. Some cabins have air conditioning. Some get hot!
- Cabin Colored Clothing** Arrive dressed in as much of your cabin color as possible!
- Pirate Attire** (for TUES DINNER)
Bring your best pirate costume to wear Tuesday evening (or all week if you're in the spirit!). Points for the best dressed cabin.
- Mission Impossible Clothing** Dress in your darkest clothes for this evening challenge.
- Masquerade Ball Formal Attire**
Bring your fun & fancy dress-up outfit for FRIDAY's dinner & party. Campers will be able to make a mask during craft time (or bring one from home!).
- Cabin décor** Campers are welcome to bring cabin colored/themed decorations to decorate their cabin.
- Free time activities such as Frisbee, cards, books, journal, etc.**
